## **About the Cover**

### Fairport Harbor West Breakwater Lighthouse

This charming forty-two foot tower, with its attached two-story keeper's cottage, sits near the end of the west breakwater that shields the manmade harbor of Fairport. The harbor, in turn, protects the mouth of the Grand River, which has served as one of the region's most important commercial hubs. It is also the home port of four of our member clubs; my home club - River's Edge Yacht Club, Western Reserve Yacht Club, Fairport Harbor Yacht Club, and Grand River Yacht Club. It is also home of the well-known Pickle Bill's Restaurant.

It has a long history of existence dating back to the 1920's. Over the years, it has displayed several different characteristics, starting with a fixed red lens lantern. In 1925, a Fresnel lens with characteristics of an occulting white light every five seconds. (Light three seconds, eclipse two seconds). Fairport Harbor Breakwater Lighthouse is now automated and its Fresnel lens has been replaced with a modern optic. This June, the light will have shone for over 100 years.

In 2005, Fairport Harbor West Breakwater Lighthouse, deemed excess by the Coast Guard, was offered at no cost to eligible entities. including federal, state, and local agencies, non-profit corporations, and educational organizations under the provisions of the National Historic Lighthouse Preservation Act of 2000. No qualified owner was found. The General Service Administration put the lighthouse on the auction block in 2009. Over the next few years, there were several unsuccessful bids. In 2011, after several more unsuccessful bids, a winning bid was accepted by Sheila Consaul of Virginia. She announced plans to use the structure as a personal summer home, although she would be faced with various challenges such as providing running water, which is ironic considering that it's on Lake Erie. Every summer, she has allowed a day of tours to the lighthouse to see what she has accomplished.

Since the lighthouse is privately owned these days, I reached out to Ms. Consaul for her permission to use this picture and she was gracious enough to give me her blessing. Many thanks to her.

In closing, I want to say that when traveling home from a long boat trip, either traveling home from the west side or the east side, there is nothing more comforting than to see that Fairport Harbor West Breakwater Lighthouse and know that you had a fun trip behind you and a safe journey home.

The Political Action Committee represents the association at meetings and interfaces with politicians on the local, state, and national level to express the needs of boaters. The GCBA represents the interests of all types of boaters including sail, power, and paddle. Many of our members enjoy all these aspects of our sport. The waters of the great lakes should be preserved from pollution, invasive species, and regulations that impact the enjoyment of this great natural resource. Our political action committee will be vigilant on all these fronts.

Some of the critical issues we face include:

- Harmful algae bloom
- Invasive species
- E-15 fuel
- Dredging recreational harbors
- Stopping water withdrawal from the Great Lakes
- Wind farm in Lake Erie
- High water level impact, low ice coverage
- G5 Cellphone interference with GPS
- Survival of yacht clubs faced with government push for public access to Lake Erie shoreline
- Boating safety including Electric Shock Drowning prevention, boating safety training

To further our reach in the interests of recreational boaters, the GCBA participates with the following organizations:

## **Political Action Update**

#### **Project Icebreaker Windmills**

Ohio Citizens opposing this project to install six large windmills in the Lake off Lakewood to generate electric power have won their battle. The project is suspended for lack of support and funding. It may come back around so make your opinion heard in Ohio state and local government.

#### **Microplastic Particles in Lake Erie**

Waste plastic including shopping bags, water bottles, carryout food containers, and clothes washing wastewater is a new pollution concern. Plastic is in everything we touch. It pollutes our environment and is now getting found in seashore and water from Lake Erie. The plastics get essentially ground up into microscopic sized particles by the lake ecology system. Studies are underway to determine the need and the methods available to control our intake of this pollution. It also gets into lake fish and other wildlife. The GCBA will update news on this topic.

#### **CHEERS in Cleveland**

The Cleveland Harbor Eastern Embayment Resilience Strategy (CHEERS) project is now in the design phase. This 30-year long mission is intended to make the lakeshore from east of the Cuyahoga River out to MLK Blvd more natural, more useful, and more accessible to residents. Dredged material will become a new island accessible by residents. The GCBA has recently been accepted as a stakeholder by project management. It is our goal to represent boaters' needs and interests as the project develops into reality. Check the internet for more details. If boaters are quiet, we will not be happy with the plan. Let us know what you think!

#### **Clean Marinas**

Ohio Sea Grant has been active promoting Marinas and Yacht or Boat Clubs become active participants in the Clean Marinas program. They will help your club in this process. Their help is friendly and free of charge. The Ohio EPA is enforcing a 2018 change in the Clean Water Act that requires many marinas to adopt steps like containing boat bottom powerwash runoff and dispose of the polluted water appropriately. Storm water runoff is also a controlled situation. The Clean Marina process will provide free help understanding the EPA requirements and help your club obtain required certificates from them.

#### **Forever Chemicals in the Lake**

Microplastics are not the only Lake pollutant coming into focus. Perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl compounds, known as PFAS, are found in fish in every lake, including importantly, the Great Lakes. These are know as forever chemicals. They accumulate in all of us and wildlife around lakes. Fish included. Industrial runoff is a major source of these chemicals. Michigan companies are working on a carbon filter to reduce these chemicals from reaching the lake. This is an emerging concern the GCBA will follow and report on.

#### Federal Law to Help Lake Erie

A federal bill signed into law includes provisions to protect water quality and combat invasive species in Lake Erie.

U.S. President signed the law which earmarks almost \$817 billion to the Defense Department. One of the provisions pertains to the dredged materials hauled up from the bottom of Lake Erie when the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers carries out dredging in Ohio's eight federally recognized harbor. Let's all keep an eye on this one as well H2O Ohio clean water efforts to limit farm runoff that causes algae bloom

#### Avon Power Plant Project

"STACKS" visible from the Lake at Avon Point are part of an electric power plant which has been decommissioned. A project is underway to replace the plant with modern condominiums and retail buildings including a nice area for citizens to enjoy a view of the Lake. This is really happening now! Demolition has begun. The tallest Stack will be left in place as it provides a line of sight high speed data link between New York and Chicago stock exchanges. All else is to be removed. Plans include a boat marina with up to 50 ft long docks possible. As many as 150 to 180 docks will be included. A haul out pit is part of the plan and potentially an off site storage located a short distance away. A developer has not been selected for the marina yet, but the plan includes it to be completed by 2025.

Look for more public meetings in the area as development continues.

## LAKESIDE YACHT CLUB

Lakeside Yacht Club has been a strong supporter of GCBA; allowing us to hold our monthly E-Board meetings at their clubhouse. In appreciation of their support, it was our honor to name Lakeside Yacht Club - **"Club of the Year"**. Accepting the award on behalf of Lakeside Yacht Club was GCBA Past Commander John May.

Lakeside Yacht Club was founded in July 1930 and secured a lease at the site of the Old Cleveland Yacht Club lagoon on the 9th Street Pier, downtown Cleveland. One year later, they were forced to move to their new home at East 49th Street. They have endured many trials and tribulations over the years with fires, hurricanes, storms, and growing pains, but have still prevailed. The current clubhouse they occupy was opened in 1968, and with the determination and perseverance of their club members, have grown with many new amenities including fuel docks, pool, extension of the clubhouse, outside accessible showers/restrooms and more.

The continual improvements allow Lakeside Yacht Club to enjoy a growing membership and an outstanding reputation among Great Lakes guest boaters.

## **MOST PARTICIPATION AWARD**



#### CHAGRIN RIVER YACHT CLUB Accepted by Christopher Aune

Albert Boland purchased the property in 1964. The idea of starting a boat club in 1965 was Elmer and Bobbie Locsei along with Albert Boland. The club started with 15 members with our first elected Commodore Robert Sopko.

During those first years many improvements took place. In 1966 the club added a World War II crane. 1972 with financial help from Albert Boland a carryall was purchased. Also, in 1972 Hurricane Agnes barreled down on Lake Erie. The following year boaters looked for a place to dock to be protected from the severe storms that blow across Lake Erie's waters, the club quickly doubled in membership, that same year a newly formed Non-Profit Corporation began, called **The Chagrin River Yacht Club**.

In 1974, under Commodore Jack Cole CRYC applied to be part of the Interlake's Yachting Association. During this period CRYC became a well-known participant in yachting and boating activities along the south shore of Lake Erie. A great deal of credit for the efforts of the club's image and public relations are due to the three members dedicated and untiring efforts on behalf of all Great Lakes Yachtsmen. We honor these men, P/C Eric Schneider, Past Commander of the Greater Cleveland Boating Association, Past Commander of the Coast Guard Flotilla 77 and twice Man of the Year Jim Cronin, P/C Norm Gallagher who is the Past President District 7 International order of the Blue Gavel for their accomplishments and loyal members Dan Rydzinski, Dean Ruff, Bud Merrifield and Ron May for his commitment to the very survival of the club. In 1982 Ron Sr. and Gayle Kahoun purchased the grounds and still own it today.

Today CRYC member Christopher Aune carries on this tradition as he served as CRYC Commodore in 2014, Commander of the Greater Cleveland Boating Association in 2018, President of District 7 International Order of the Blue Gavel in 2023, and Trustee for I-LYA currently in 2025.

## With the continued support of its members and Bridge Officers, CRYC is still recognized as a resolute supporter of yachting organizations.

## The Joe Chase Memorial Benefit Fund

The Joe Chase Memorial Benefit Fund was named after the late <u>Joe Chase</u> in recognition of his years of service to the *Greater Cleveland Boating Association* and for his dedication to the boating community.

Joe helped organize the Lake County Yacht Club and West Channel Yacht Club. He was a past Commodore of the Lake County Yacht Club and a charter member of the West Channel Yacht Club. He was Chairman and secretary of the Chagrin River Association and was very active in securing funds for the Chagrin River wing wall project.

Joe worked for the Inter-Lake Yachting Association and was one of the organizers of the Power Boat Regatta. He was Chairman of the regatta that was held at Kelly's Island and was awarded the *"Skipper of the Year*' that year. This regatta was sponsored by the **GCBA** and the following year, the Power Boat Regatta was approved and adopted by the **I-LYA** and has since been held in Put-in-Bay.

He was Chairman of the Bowling Tournament and Banquet for many years. He also served as Chairman of the Commander's Ball for over 12 years. Joe was selected in 1987 as **GCBA** *"Man of the Year."* 

*The Joe Chase Memorial Benefit Fund* was organized in 1992 by the **GCBA** to directly help its recipients. Contributions have been made by many deserving organizations over the years. Going forward, contributions will focus on boating safety and boating education.

Money for the fund is budgeted yearly from fundraiser and donations from member yacht clubs, individuals, and organizations.

## **HISTORY OF** GREATER CLEVELAND BOATING ASSOCIATION

The Greater Cleveland Boating Association is a non-profit Ohio chartered organization consisting of representatives of fifty-two boating and yachting clubs located on the south shore of Lake Erie in Ashtabula, Lake, Cuyahoga, Lorain and Erie counties. Delegates from member clubs attend monthly meetings at the various clubs.

GCBA is dedicated to the advancement of aquatic recreation in all forms, including boating, fishing, swimming and the development of necessary facilities. GCBA represents approximately 8,000 club-affiliated boat owners as well as countless thousands of others. GCBA is the eyes, ears and voice of this ever-growing group of sportsmen and is constantly alert to help provide new facilities and protect the existing ones against destruction.

GCBA was founded in 1946. Following are but a few of the most notable GCBA achievements.

- **1946** GCBA conducted city-wide regattas that attracted thousands of spectators to Cleveland's waterfront.
- 1952 Construction of a divided freeway, the marginal roadway now known as the Shoreway and proposed relocation of Cleveland Builders' Supply would have destroyed Forest City Yacht Club and Gordon Shore Boat Club. GCBA caused CBSC to be located on the Cuyahoga River and kept the boating facilities safe in their present locations.
- 1953 GCBA obtained 40,000 signatures on petitions asking for small boat facilities in the Department of Port Control. Cleveland constructed the first small boat launching ramps for free public use at a cost of \$600 each. They were constructed at Wildwood Park, Gordon Park, East 49th and Donald Gray Garden.
- **1954** GCBA assisted Wildwood Yacht Club in obtaining a lease and established its location at the foot of Neff Road.
- 1957 GCBA was instrumental in having weather conditions broadcast along the south shore of Lake Erie. In the sixties GCBA continued to work in such areas as lease renewal. GCBA provided representatives to speak against legislation aimed at boaters.
- 1978 Ohio was given stewardship of Cleveland's lakefront parks and GCBA learned of ODNR's intention to assume control of Cleveland's yachting and boating clubs. ODNR indicated that the private clubs would be pre-empted, become public marinas and the docks would be allocated on an annual raffle system. GCBA opposed this move and succeeded in obtaining fifteen-year leases for all clubs in the Cleveland State Park System.

- 1979 GCBA caused a city ordinance to be passed prohibiting the use of gill nets within a two mile limit of the shoreline. GCBA sent representatives to meetings in Columbus which resulted in the abolition of all gill nets in Ohio. GCBA also assisted in having Ohio's Walleye fish declared a game fish, and as such, be protected from commercial netters.
- **1982** Ohio, in its rehabilitation plan for Wildwood Park, intended to abolish the east small boat launching ramp. GCBA protested and the State subsequently modified its plans and this ramp is still in useful operation.
- 1983 Edgewater Park boat ramps were about to be redesigned so that several of the boat ramps would be lost. GCBA intervened and Edgewater ramps are still intact. GCBA provided leadership in motivating the construction of a breakwall at the mouth of the Chagrin River.
- **1984** ODNR planned to narrow the entrance into the harbor at Wildwood Park. GCBA recommended an offshore breakwall instead and the State agreed.
- 1987 GCBA formally created a Political Action Committee. They successfully opposed a plan by the State which would have eliminated security fences, relocated boat storage and installed a bike path through the clubs on the Cleveland waterfront.
- 1988 GCBA collected 10,000 signatures on petitions supporting a ban on phosphates in detergents in the 35 counties in the Lake Erie Basin. This grass roots effort resulted in passage of a bill which was signed into law by Governor Celeste at Lakeside Yacht Club.
- **1989** GCBA conducted a public opinion poll to determine the need for mandatory boat licensing.
- **1990** GCBA opposed the new boater tax as unjust and recommended immediate repeal.
- **1992** Established the Joe Chase Memorial Benefit Fund. Recommended voluntary boating education as opposed to mandatory operator's licensing.
- **1993** GCBA assisted with the repeal of the ship station license fee for marine radios.
- **1994** GCBA received an award from the National Water Safety Congress in appreciation of the organization's active leadership to promote boating safety through its PAC.
- **1997-98** Succeeded in modifying the INS inspection program for small boats returning from Canada. Thirteen videophones have been installed along the Ohio lakefront. Established a motto GCBA: The voice of the recreational boater.
- **1999** After four years of petitioning, the Ohio legislature finally increased the gas revenue tax allocated to the Waterway Safety Fund from 1/2% to 3/4%.
- **2000** GCBA, in conjunction with BAO, successfully lobbied for an increase in the gas tax allocated to the Waterway Safety Fund. The 1/8% is approximately \$2 million.
- **2001** Inducted five new clubs into GCBA, expanding both our size and area.

- 2002 GCBA was instrumental in having the Grand River dredged up to the Federal Waterway. GCBA is recognized nationally as the only recreational boating association that initiates legislation thru political activity.
- 2003 GCBA provided leadership to the lakefront clubs in their opposition of the elimination/ destruction of these clubs. Also active in the lakefront development process for Cleveland.
- **2004-05** GCBA continued to monitor the recommendations of the Cleveland Lakefront Development Plan as it effected the clubs and the recreational boater.
- **2008** GCBA petitions at boat shows to support creation of a national ballast water standard which would apply only to commercial ships.
- 2010 Solicited petitions at the annual Boat Show to reject any petitions for a waiver of the Clean Air Act to allow distribution of E15. We urged studies to determine the effects of mid-level ethanol blends on the safety and operability of existing marine engines in America's recreational boats.
- **2011** GCBA continues to monitor the ethanol issue in marine gas as it effects marine engines and their parts.
- **2012** GCBA has been vigilant in following the algae bloom, asian carp and water removal problems in the Great Lakes
- **2013** The GCBA is still following the issue to raise the gas to E15, which we and the marine industry oppose as being harmful to boat engines and cause expensive repairs.
- **2014** GCBA conducted surveys at the Mid-America Boat Show to see how boaters feel about the installation of wind turbines on Lake Erie.
- **2015** GCBA petioned the state of ohio to continue the waterway safety council and continued to support the efforts to clean up the algae blooms in Lake Erie.
- 2016 GCBA collected petions at Mid American Boat Show to save the Waterway Safety Council to protect the Waterway Safety Fund
- 2017 GCBA partnered with the Lake Erie Foundation to have petitions signed to limit the allowable amount of phosphorus from manure and fertilizers that find its way into the Lake and to have the Governor declare the Western Basin of Lake Erie impaired under the Clean Water Act.
- 2018 GCBA informed boaters of the Kidde fire extinguisher recall at the Mid American Boat Show. We also gave away a new electronic flare unit and also collected Hawaiian Shirts for the Hawaiian Shirts for deployed soldiers GCBA partnered with LEMTA to stop installation of wind turbines in Lake Erie.
- 2019 GCBA & LEMTA continued their work to stop the installation of wind turbines on Lake Erie. Boaters experienced record high water levels resulting in docks under water and flooding in some areas.

- 2020 GCBA and other organizations, faced with the Covid 19 Pandemic required many events to be cancelled. To keep everyone's health and safety a priority, the GCBA E-Board continued their meetings via zoom in order to continue their work for water safety. High water levels continued in 2020.
- 2021 GCBA has implemented all meetings to be virtual and in person. Improvements to the Joe Chase Memorial Benefit Fund have been made working with local law enforcement agencies by doing vessel safety checks at random Edgewater boat ramps while also being involved in supporting OBEC class thru ODNR. Also we have started a new fundraiser for the Joe Chase Memorial Benefit Fund at Rock-n-Dock every summer 2022 will be the second one.
- **2022** GCBA has converted from a 501 C6 to a 501 C3 helping with donation tax deductions and to help the organization grow. This will also help with possible receiving grants to help boaters in our organization.

GCBA started active participation in State of Ohio Water Safety Council and the Ohio.

- 2023 GCBA Informed member clubs of changes in the Clean Water Act that could affect clubs by requiring storm water run-off and wastewater (bottom power washing runoff) permits from the Ohio EPA.
- 2024 Windmills in Lake Erie project put on hold after citizen feedback and opposition by boater organizations along with funding short comings finally worked.
  GCBA became recognized as a stakeholder in the Cleveland lakefront project (CHEERS). Will express boater interests as the project unfolds over the next 30 years.

- 5. PRESS AND HOLD THE TRANSMIT BUTTON
- 6. CLEARLY SAY: "MAYDAY MAYDAY MAYDAY"

  - VESSEL NAME AND/OR DESCRIPTION
  - POSITION AND/OR LOCATION
  - NATURE OF EMERGENCY
  - NUMBER OF PEOPLE ON BOARD
- 8. RELEASE THE TRANSMIT BUTTON
- 9. WAIT 30 SECONDS IF NO RESPONSE, REPEAT "MAYDAY" CALL

## **VESSEL ACCIDENTS**

Vessel Accidents (ORC 1547.10, ORC 1547.59 and OAC 1501:47-1-09)

The operator of a vessel Involved in a collision or accident, to the extent possible without risking serious danger to their own vessel, crew and passengers, shall render assistance as may be practicable and necessary. Any person who renders assistance at the scene of an accident involving a vessel is not liable in a civii action for damages or injury from any act or omission in rendering assistance, except for willful or wanton misconduct. The operator having knowledge of the accident or collision shall immediately stop and remain at the scene, to the extent that it is safe and practical, and give the operator's name and address and the boat owner's name and address, and registration number to any person injured or to the operator, owner or attendant of any vessel damaged or to a law enforcement officer. If the accident results in loss of life, disappearance of an occupant, injury requiring medical treatment beyond first aid, damage to property in excess of \$1,000 or complete loss of a vessel, the operator shall file a full report on a prescribed form. If the operator is incapacitated, an officer shall file the form.

#### **Violation Resulting In Injury or Damage is Evidence of Negligence** (ORC 1547.34)

Violations of watercraft law that result In Injury to persons or damage to property shall constitute prima-facie evidence of negligence in a civil action.

## OUI — OPERATING UNDER THE INFLUENCE

## Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs Prohibited; Testing

<u>ORC 1547.11</u> Operation, control, or manipulation under influence of alcohol or drug & <u>ORC 1547.111</u> Implied consent to chemical test

No person shall operate or be in physical control of any vessel underway, or manipulate any water skis or similar device if the person is under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

NOTE: It is an offense to operate a vessel while having a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of 0.08 or more. A BAC less than 0.08 is admissable in court along with other evidence of impairment to prove operating under the influence. For persons under 21 years of age, it is an offense to operate a vessel while having a BAC of 0.02 or more. Further, it is an offense for persons under the age of 21 to purchase, possess, consume, or be under the influence of alcohol.

#### Penalty for Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs

Any person who operates a vessel, water skis or similar device shall be deemed to have given consent to a chemical test or tests of their blood, breath, or urine to determine alcohol or drug content if arrested. If a person under arrest refuses to submit to a chemical test the person is prohibited from operating a vessel or water skis or from registering a vessel for a one-year period. If the person is the owner of the vessel the registration certificate and tags will be impounded for a one-year period.

## CARRYING REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT

#### REQUIRED ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Life Jacket(s)
- Fire Extinguisher(s) (on most gasoline powered craft) 12 yr expiration now
- Anchor and Line
- Visual Distress Signal(s)
- Sound Signaling Device
- Navigation Lights

- Ventilation System (gasoline powered only)
- Backfire Flame Arrestor
  (gas engines, except outboards)
- Exhaust Muffling Device (or underwater exhaust)
- Engine cut off switch lanyard (PWC only)

#### ITEMS MUST BE:

- U.S. Coast Guard Approved
- In Good Serviceable Condition
- Readily Accessible

• Life Jackets Must be Correct Size for each person

**SAFETY TIP:** The items required vary by vessel type and length. Consult the Required Equipment Chart in the Ohio Boat Operator's Guide for details.

## **BOATING COURSE or EXAM REQUIREMENT**

Persons born on or after 1/1/1982 must successfully complete a NASBLA approved boating course or proficiency exam prior to operating a powercraft more than 10 horsepower. When operating a rental powercraft more than 10 horsepower, they must do one of the following:

- Sign a statement that they have completed an approved boating course or proficiency exam.
- Receive educational material from the rental business and pass an exam given by the rental business (only good for that day).

#### CHANNEL MARKER BUOYS

All-green and all-red companion buoys indicate that the boating channel is between them. The red buoy is on the right side of the channel when facing upstream.



### **OPERATING YOUR BOAT SAFELY**

#### **RECKLESS OPERATION**

Reckless operation laws apply to any person operating any type of vessel and includes persons being towed on water skis or any other device. Reckless operation includes operating:

- · Carelessly or heedlessly
- · In disregard of the rights or safety of any person, vessel or property
- Without due caution, at a rate of speed or in a manner that endangers any person, vessel or property

#### UNSAFE OPERATION

Unsafe operation laws apply to any person operating any type of vessel and requires that a vessel be operated in a reasonable and prudent manner at all times. Unsafe operation includes:

- Becoming airborne while crossing the wake of another vessel at a distance less than 100 feet or at an unsafe distance
- Operating at a speed and proximity to another vessel (or person being towed on water skis on other device) that requires either vessel to swerve abruptly to avoid a collision
- · Operating less than 200 feet directly behind a person water skiing
- · Weaving through congested traffic

#### **UNSAFE CONDITIONS**

By Ohio law, all of the following are unsafe conditions. An operator may be ordered to remove a vessel from the water if these situations exist:

- Insufficient life jackets
- Insufficient fire extinguisher(s)
- Overloaded, causing insufficient freeboard for the water conditions
- Improper navigation lights
- · Fuel leaks or fuel in the bilges
- Inadequate backfire flame control
- · Improper ventilation

**SAFETY FOR PWC OPERATORS:** If a PWC engine returns to idle or shuts off during high speed operation, you will lose all ability to control the steering. You must use the throttle to swerve or otherwise maneuver to avoid a collision.

#### NO WAKE & IDLE SPEED ZONES

These zones may be marked by bouys with an orange circle. These zones also include all areas within 300 feet of any dock, launch ramp, marina, harbor entrance, etc. Many lakes have an unmarked "shore zone" designated as "no wake." "Idle speed" and "no wake" means the slowest possible speed needed to maintain steerage and maneuverability.



## **OBEYING NAVIGATION RULES**

The Navigation Rules are laws which help boat operators avoid collisions. The Navigation Rules include three major responsibilities:

- Practice good seamanship
- Keep a proper lookout
- Maintain a safe speed

The Navigation Rules include Steering Rules which direct a vessels actions when approaching other vessels. The steering rules use the following terms:

**Give-way Vessel** – a vessel directed by a rule to keep out of the way of another vessel. A give-way vessel must take early and substantial (obvious) action to keep well clear.

**Stand-on Vessel** – a vessel directed by a rule to maintain its course and speed. A stand-on vessel must take action to avoid a collision if a give-way vessel is not taking necessary action.

When taking action(s) to avoid a collision, the action must be made in ample time, must result in passing at a safe distance, and changes in course or speed must be obvious.

**SAFETY TIP:** Give-way to boats that are less maneuverable than your boat such as barges, tugs, commercial boats, sailboats and non-powered boats.
